CITY ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT January 23, 2017 PC Meeting

Major Projects/Engineering

- Water Tanks The first foundation of one of the water tanks has been placed and the second is scheduled for the week of January 23rd. The project is still scheduled to be completed by the end of March.
- Wastewater/Leachate The City will begin negotiation s with Republic Service over the next several months to decide if we will move forward with the project and how. I will give continual updates on this.

Planning/Permits

- Serve Pro Tim McGinnis is securing his funding and his project start date has been pushed back to late March early April.
- **Tim Cornelius** Tim has been meeting with the State and the County to clarify the conservation easement and the wetlands. Tim is expecting to have his application into the planning commission in April.
- CSME (Corvallis Society of Model Engineers) -- The City has been working with the Model Railroad to come to an agreement on relocating them to one of the barracks buildings. Discussions are getting closer to a resolve. The idea is that they will move in the next few years as the City gets the building closer to occupancy.
- **Property Across from City Hall** The Benton County Commissioners voted unanimously on January 17th to give the property to the City. This has been worked on for more than 30 years. We have submitted our application to the Federal Government to receive the deed. Once the City has the deed we can begin the process of getting the property out of parks in perpetuity.
- **Downtown Square** The town square has been completed and Brittany Kennedy the City Recreation Coordinator will be looking at utilizing the space for markets and for community events. We currently have Founders Day on May 13th and then a weekday farmers market planned.
